Tips from the police

Recently, several persons from Eastern Europe have been robbed of their money which happened when they were on the road in a car or in a truck. The Dutch Police therefore provides the following tips and warnings.

1. Do not take large sums of money in cash. Pay in a digital format if it concerns a large sum of money!

- 2. The perpetrators sometimes ask after money and they say they want to check it.
- 3. There are incidents in which the perpetrators pose as police officers. If you have to stop, the Dutch Police have a stopping sign with illuminated letters either in the car or on top of the car. Police officers generally wear

a uniform.
