



Beware of robbery

Tips from the police

Recently, several persons from Eastern Europe have been robbed of their money which happened when they were on the road in a car or in a truck. The Dutch Police therefore provides the following tips and warnings.

1. Do not take large sums of money in cash. Pay in a digital format if it concerns a large sum of money!
2. The perpetrators sometimes ask after money and they say they want to check it.
3. There are incidents in which the perpetrators pose as police officers. If you have to stop, the Dutch Police have a stopping sign with illuminated letters either in the car or on top of the car. Police officers generally wear a uniform.
