Woman stabbed to death

On New Year's Day 2013, 48-year-old Marja Nijholt is found dead on the driveway of a house in Oss, on Berghemseweg. She has been stabbed to death.

Marja lives in Enschede and goes on New Year's Eve by train to Oss. She arrives there at around 2:00 PM. She has a dark coloured ladies bike and a grey wheeled suitcase with her. Marja visits various cafés. Until about 9:00 PM she is seen several times and speaks to various

people. She is looking for a place to sleep. The bike and suitcase are still in her possession.

Between 02:30 and 06:55 AM she is seen several times and speaks to people. She still has her suitcase with her, but not her bike. What happened to the bicycle is not known. Marja is last seen around 06:55 AM at the bicycle tunnel on Osseweg in Berghem.

On the evening of 2 January 1998 Salvatore Nicolosi (34 years old) leaves his home, a terraced house in Heerhugowaard. He lives there with his wife and two children and works as a window cleaner. He left for a moment for an appointment, but does not come back. His wife reports him as missing. Salvatore is found on Sunday 4 January at the industrial site De Baanstee II in Purmerend. He appears to have been murdered and then set on fire. It has never been

established who he had an appointment with that evening of 2 January and who did this to him. In 1987 Salvatore came from Sicily to the Netherlands to build a better life here. Unfortunately, this was not to be. Thur you have any idea what happened? Please let us know. You could help Salvatore's wife and children to come to terms with the loss of their husband and father.

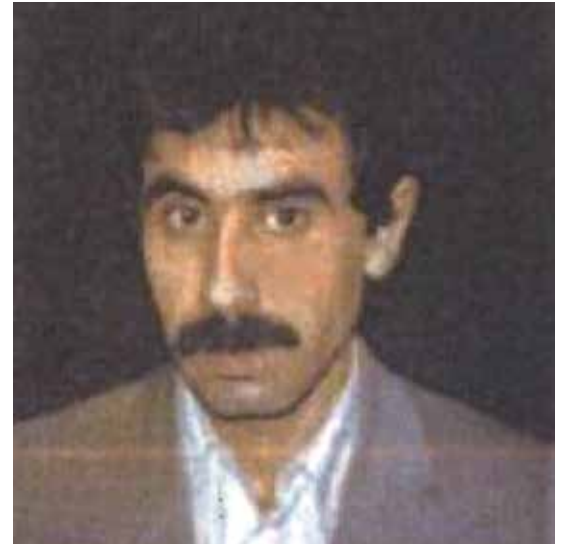
Hayrettin lived in Amsterdam in Reina Prinsen Geerligstraat. On 14 September 1995 he is last seen by his brother at around 5:00 PM.

Hayrettin drove away in his brother's car. Three days later

his brother reports him missing. According to friends and family he had seemed nervous for quite some time.

It is not clear what happened to Hayrettin. Nor is it possible to determine exactly when he died. His next of kin would like to know what has happened to him in that period of just over a year.

Baby in the ice

Three children are playing in the cold on the Sunday afternoon of 29 January 2006 in the park at Torontostraat near the 'Kapperskolk' in Doetinchem. When one of them is picked up by her father, she tells him that she has seen a baby in the ice.

Her brother later says that they had played with the reeds on the ice and that he also saw the baby. His mother and aunt go out to investigate. To their horror what the children tell them is true: there is a baby in the ice.

They report the terrible find to the police.

The child in the ice appears to be a new-born boy with a white skin and dark blond hair. The investigation reveals that the child had lived and was killed in a violent attack.

Murder of Piet Baams

On Christmas Day 1996 his children do not find their father at home. Later it turns out that the last sighting of 85-year-old Piet Baams was on 22 December. About six weeks later, the police find his body in the water 'Boven Merwede' in the village of Gorinchem. There is a leather belt or cord around his neck.

Piet lived in the nursing home Nieuw Malderborgh in Nijmegen. He was full of spirit and helpful and often received visits from his children and grandchildren (and

great-grandchildren). After his wife died in early 1996, Piet Baams lived alone. He went fishing and played billiards regularly and took part in the weekly bingo. He was active on the board of the fishing club and was a member of the residents committee of Nieuw Malderborgh.

His family has been living in uncertainty for more than twenty years. Do you know who killed Piet Baams? And why? Please let us know.

Houseboat occupant dies

Bernard (Ben) Stubbe hasn't been seen since the turn of the year 2003/2004. On 19 January 2004 his son reports him missing. The police investigate, but they cannot find him. Ben is 55 years old and lives alone on a houseboat at Energieweg in Groningen.

Ben's body is found on 10 February 2004. It is in the water of Hoendiep near his houseboat.

The investigation shows that his video store card was used on 7 January. It is not clear how he died. A crime cannot be ruled out.

After all these years his children still don't know what happened to Ben. Do you know anything about the disappearance and the death of Ben Stubbe? Please let us know.

Mike Duif is found in a pool of blood at his home. He has been shot dead.

Mike worked for the computer company Hewlett Packard (HP), but lost his job. After that he started trading in computers and computer components.

In the night before his death, Mike went to a disco in Hilversum with friends. After closing time (05:00 AM) he drops friends off at home. Then he goes to the Zandpad

in Utrecht. He had said that he wanted to get some coke. Around 07:00 AM Mike drops the last friend off at home.

Around 09:30 AM Mike is lying in bed and is seen by a fellow resident. This fellow resident returns home at about 7:00 PM. He sees that the whole house has been turned upside down. He finds Mike's body in the kitchen.

Who killed Mike Duif? Why? Family and friends would like to know the answers to these questions.

Missing for 46 years

The last time Alwin Sterk is seen is on Monday 24 April 1972 in Amsterdam. Alwin was almost 21 years old at the time. He grew up in Ede and in 1972 he was living with a woman in Amsterdam, in the student flat Zilverberg of the University of Amsterdam in Amsterdam Noord. He had enrolled for a course at the social academy there. Alwin was in the alternative circuit and did volunteer work in the non-violent resistance.

Shortly before he went missing he sent a card to his family. After that, nothing was ever heard of him again. Now, 46 years later, the family still have questions about where Alwin could be. Lieneke found dead

On Wednesday, 5 May 1993, the police receive a telephone call: a woman has been found dead, clearly as a result of violence. Lieneke was 63 years old.

As a twenty-year-old Lieneke Troost catches polio. Despite her physical disability, she still works as a typist for a long time at TNO. She is financially independent. She receives a pension, benefits from the municipality and an inheritance. But she is dependent physically. Almost throughout the

whole day she is helped by a pool of about sixty private carers from an institution. Some caregivers take her out with them, even though they no longer work for the institution. Lieneke has a lot of contact with family, neighbours, friends and former colleagues. She also goes out with them. When she is almost sixty, she still goes to Spain with her family. Her next of kin would like to know what happened to her. Do you know anything about this? Please let us know. *Read the interview on the next page*

'This should not go unpunished'.

The lifeless body of disabled Lieneke Troost (63) is found in her bed. It is clear that she has been violently attacked. More than 25 years later, her brother still doesn't know what happened in the night of May 4 to May 5, 1993 at Kerckwervelaan in Oegstgeest.

'Lieneke got polio at the age of twenty. After undergoing all kinds of operations, she was able to look after herself to some extent. For a long time she lived at home with our mother. After our mother's death, she moved into a sheltered home in Oegstgeest. We saw each other regularly, although I wasn't all that close with my family.

'Do I still believe that the case will one day be solved?'

I can still remember that day. My wife was called by the police. Something had happened to one of my sisters. It was serious. When I arrived there, my sister, Lieneke's twin, was in a state of shock. She was completely distraught: Lieneke had been murdered.

It was clear that someone who knew their way around her house had taken away some money. And had been disturbed. I still suspect it was someone from her immediate surroundings.

Anyway, I can think what I want, but that won't give me my sister back. 'Do I still believe that the case will one day be solved?' Not really. But I do find it important that cold cases are

kept in the spotlight. Crimes like these simply cannot go unpunished in our

society. It's very simple. You don't get away with it, even though it can sometimes take a long time.

On Friday 11 July 2003, 20-year-old Samira van de Wal from Brunssum disappears without a trace. Samira was addicted to drugs and was a regular appearance in Heerlen's drug scene.

She earned her living as a prostitute. For a long time no one really knew where Samira was.

Almost two years later, on Friday 6 May 2005, her body is found in the Prickenis Terworm nature reserve in Heerlen.

On the Tuesday morning of 7 May 2002 Seyhmus Elmas (32) is found dead at home. An acquaintance finds him there. He turns out to have been stabbed to death. One day previously he was seen late in the evening in a coffee house near the centre of Arnhem.

The Kurdish Seyhmus was born in Turkey. He has lived in the Netherlands since 1997. First at various refugee locations, and finally at a home in Arnhem.

Seyhmus, who is single, works as a builder.

He often does jobs together with others. In the week before his death various men stayed with him. Little is known about these men.

It is also notable that at Seyhmus' home there is a portrait of a PKK (Kurdistan Workers' Party) leader.

Jan was a car mechanic. In February 1990 he started a garage company

together with a business partner in Heemraadstraat in The Hague. Jan lived in Scheveningen and was a familiar face there. He was known as a social and friendly man, who was always there for his mother and sisters.

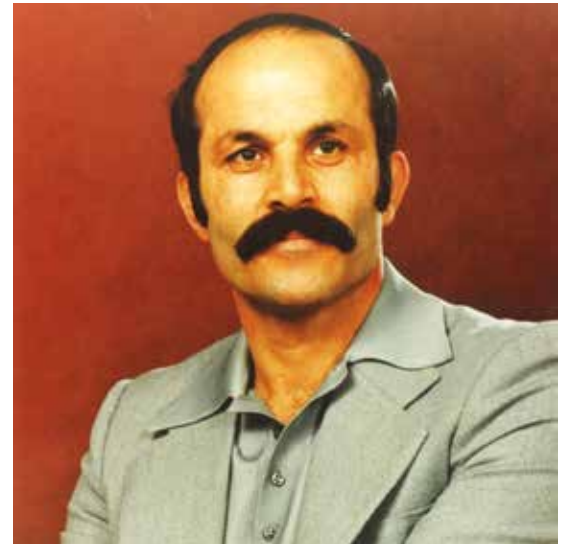

'Those images will stay with me forever'.

A fire in Hilversum robbed 20-year-old Kim Veerman of her life. The fire was lit deliberately. Eleven years later her mother Rik Stoutenbeek and stepfather Rino Bijkerk are still having to live with the consequences.

Rik: 'Kim was a very sociable girl. She was always there for everyone. She studied at the hotel school and had lived for just a few months with a friend above a house owned by the council'.
Rino: 'It was a shop selling old postage stamps. With millions and millions of stamps. One big paper factory, as it were. That night around six o'clock we were called by the owner: it was in flames.'

Rik: When we arrived at the market of Hilversum it was already crowded with people and there were many fire

engines and police cars. The flames were already coming through the roof. Kim was taken to hospital, where they tried to resuscitate her. That's what they told us.' Rino: A fireman took her out of the burning building. It was eight-hundred degrees, too dangerous. But they went in anyway.'

Rino: 'In the first few weeks I only thought about how I would take revenge. You shouldn't do that, it drives you crazy.'

Rik: 'The terrible fear she must have had, that hurts most.'

'No one teaches you how to deal with this.'

Rino: 'Her birthday on March 16, the day of the fire on September 16 and Christmas, those remain the hardest days.'

'No one teaches you how to deal with this.' For the first few months you're just in shock'.

Rik: 'I had to sell my house. Kim kept coming through the gate. Even now, when I'm doing some gardening and hear an ambulance in the village, it feels like my womb is being torn out of my body. I'll never forget those images of the market in Hilversum.'

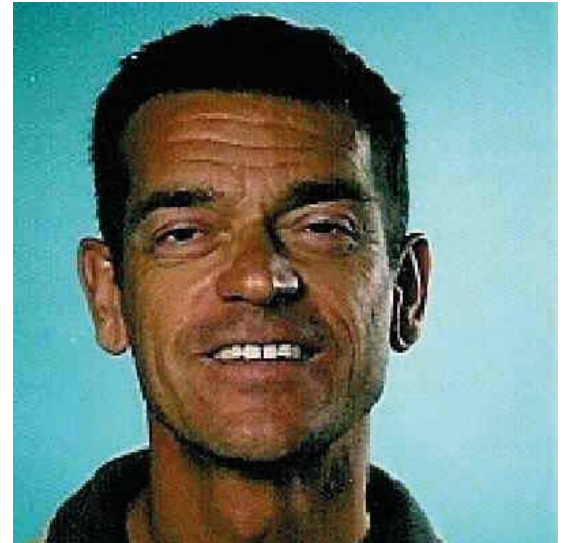

His friend walks to the Kamerlingh Onneslaan. He hears some shots from the direction where Helio parked the car.

Helio's friend sees a man stepping into a car and driving away without the car lights on. It later turns out that Helio Stewart has been shot.

Helio had a partner and a child. They have been living with the question for 25 years: Who shot Helio dead and why? Can you help them find answers?
